To develop and ensure the quality of assisted reproduction, your clinic wants to report information about your treatment(s) to Q-IVF. All reporting clinics are responsible for the registry. The registry wants to continuously monitor treatment results and any medical risks for both the IVF children and the treated patients/couples.
